A Heat Trapping Blanket

When there is too much carbon dioxide in the atmosphere, it acts like a blanket, trapping the sun's heat.

This extra heat is causing the Arctic to warm faster than anywhere else on the planet.



Polar bears make their home in the Arctic and **need sea ice** to find their main food – seals.

With sea ice melting faster than ever, bears are having a difficult time getting what they need to survive.
